**10 April 2026, Mandaluyong City, Philippines** – Basic Energy Corporation (PSE ticker symbol “BSC”; the Company) together with its collaborating companies is pleased to announce the official launch of the “Electric Transport Solution Program.” This initiative introduces a comprehensive ecosystem designed to modernize the Philippine public transport sector through a sustainable electric mobility framework.

The program was officially introduced at a launch event held at the EcoOil EDSA Mandaluyong Service Station. The event was attended by distinguished leaders from the legislative and executive branches of government, local government units, and the energy sector. The collective group is honored to have received the support of Senator Pia Cayetano and Secretary Sharon Garin of the Department of Energy (DOE).

The program also welcomed the institutional support of Mayor Francis Zamora, in his capacity as Mayor of San Juan and President of the League of Cities of the Philippines (LCP), and Atty.
